**T**he Alpha Delta Chapter House is the oldest fraternity house at the University of Maine (1902), and it needs your help to keep it strong through the next century! For only the second time in our history, the Alpha Delta Chapter is asking for assistance. In the mid-fifties Skulls met the challenge to expand the Chapter House by adding wings. Now instead of expanding, we need to renovate.

The housing corporation has been making improvements on the house over the past couple of years, but there is still so much that needs to be done. Proceeds that we receive from the Centennial Fund Raiser will go towards: a complete renovation of the head; repairing the front and back stairways; repairing the Ram ceiling (which is falling in some places); replacing the dining room furniture after 30 years of service; plus heating repair, study room improvements, redoing the trophy room, new rugs, new wallpaper and woodwork improvements.

In honor of our 100th Anniversary, we'd like to raise \$100,000 to keep Phi Kap's presence strong at the University of Maine.
